The following must be submitted with the Application form:

1. Certificate of Admission from your post high school institution.
2. Key Club activities list including:
 - ✦ All Key Club offices (elected or appointed) and the year they were held
 - ✦ Training conferences attended and the year(s) attended
 - ✦ District and International Conventions attended
 - ✦ Leadership events attended and the year(s) attended
3. Key Club service hours
 - ✦ Submit evidence of service to home, school and community through Key Club activities during your years in Key Club.
 - ✦ List the top service projects during your senior year including the service hours and your role for each activity
 - ✦ The Key Club Faculty Advisor must sign this paper acknowledging the service hours
4. A 5 paragraph essay describing a Key Club service project that has had the greatest impact on you.
5. Resume
6. Two (2) letters of recommendation:
 - ✦ One from a Kiwanian or your Key Club Faculty Advisor
 - ✦ One from an Educator other than your Key Club Faculty Advisor
